There are two rainwater harvesting packages available, depending on the size and requirements of your new home. Each package includes: a 2,500 litre Slimline West Coast Poly Rainwater tank specially designed for urban blocks, the latest technology in pumping systems, a Rainbank controller that will automatically switch to rainwater or mains water plus all piping, filters and valves. The system will be installed by a licenced plumber and will blend neatly into the environment of your new home.

THE MANUFACTURER

HOW THE SYSTEM WORKS

A rainwater harvesting system uses a rainwater tank to catch an otherwise neglected water source - rain from the roof. A selected pump is either submersed or placed next to the tank, with a connection to a separate controller. Inside the tank is a sensor/switch that monitors the water levels in your rainwater tank. This information is then relayed to the controller, which will automatically switch to rain or mains water ensuring an uninterrupted supply to the home. The system is fitted with filters and valves to ensure a good clean fill and comes ready to hook up to designated household appliances. The greatest savings are made by supplying appliances like washing machines and toilets which use large volumes of water all year round.
